#### **School leavers (under 20yrs)**

- A minimum of 42 credits at NCEA Level 2 across four subjects, with at least 12 credits in one subject; OR equivalent
- National Certificate in Tourism and Travel (Introductory Skills) (Level 2)

**Mature Students (20yrs and over)** Open Entry – no formal qualifications needed
